### **Mission:**

The first person to successfully complete the following five challenges wins the NBC LEARN Scavenger Hunt:

### **Challenge #1:**

Search for and find the resources in NBC LEARN's collections that deal specifically with [the Battle of Trenton](#). Save those titles to a new playlist named: *Scavenger Hunt-[Your First Name, First Initial of Your Last Name – e.g. CondoleezzaR]*

### **Challenge #2:**

You are a 5<sup>th</sup> grade Social Studies teacher in [New Jersey](#). Use the "State Standards" search tool to look up your grade level and subject area. Find [New Jersey](#) Strand/Standard/Cumulative Progress Indicator 6.1.8.C.2.c. - *Analyze the impact of triangular trade on multiple nations and groups*. Save the first and last titles on the list of correlated videos to your playlist.

### **Challenge #3:**

Do a simple search with the keywords "Martin Luther King." On the results page, use the "Filter By Source" function to find the three solo appearances by MLK on the NBC News program "Meet The Press." Save all three to your NBC LEARN Scavenger Hunt playlist.

### **Challenge #4:**

Using the course outlines, dive into the following course and subject areas: Social Studies > U.S. Government & Politics > Elections & Campaigns > Political Ads > History of Political Ads. Create a timeline of these political ads using the "Sort By" tool (select "Event Date" in "Ascending" order). Save the first political ad that appears to your NBC LEARN Scavenger Hunt playlist.

### **Challenge #5:**

Go to your playlist and email it to the instructor's email address displayed at the front of the room. The first person to send in the NBC LEARN Scavenger Hunt playlist with the correct videos is the winner.
